Mediation is a process in which an impartial third party (the mediator) facilitates communication and negotiation and promotes voluntary decision making by the parties to the dispute. Mediators help parties understand each others'™ perspectives and discuss options for settlement.

### **Mediation**

Preparing for the mediation starts with the parties agreeing to mediate. This involves agreeing the terms and procedures for the mediation (e.g., confidentiality, authority, representation, duration, procedure, costs, etc.) and appointing a mediator. It typically requires signing a formal mediation agreement.
